### RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- 1. Southern Arizona Ivy Foundation reserves the right to suspend, change or terminate this program at any time.
- 2. The interpretation, application and administration of this program shall be determined solely by the Southern Arizona Ivy Foundation and all decisions made by the Southern Arizona Ivy Foundation shall be final.
- 3. The maximum scholarship grant to any single recipient in any single academic year shall not exceed the full tuition amount assessed or charged by the educational institution for that year.
- 4. Scholarships are not transferable to any other persons and are for the sole and exclusive use and benefit of the scholarship awardees only.
- 5. The scholarship recipient shall immediately notify the Southern Arizona Ivy Foundation upon the occurrence of the following events:
  - a. The student becomes ineligible due to failing grades, dropouts, failure to matriculate, suspension or withdrawal
  - b. The student completes his or her academic work or graduates.
- 6. Scholarships recipients must be US citizens and living in Pima or Cochise County of Southern Arizona.
- 7. Scholarships award decisions are based on the candidates' grade point averages, references, recommendations from teachers, commendations received, level of involvement in school and community activities. Applicants must possess an academic GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 8. ALL scholarship funds are paid directly to the educational institution.
- 9. Scholarship awards must be claimed and/or utilized by recipients within one year of the award.
- 10. Incomplete applications or those which are received after the deadline will not be considered.

The Southern Arizona Ivy Foundation shall have sole discretion to award its scholarships based on evaluation of each candidate.
